The fund helps facilitate private sector projects which create employment and economic growth opportunities in regional areas outside South East Queensland facing significant economic and employment challenges.

Financial assistance ranging from \$100,000 to over \$10 million is available for proponents to apply directly.

Applications are assessed under an appropriate set of criteria and the type and level of assistance is determined on a case-by-case basis.
